Piece	Instrumentation	Musical features	Aol?	Notes
Kalush Orchestra - Stefania	Mostly synths and drum machines  Vocals are harmonised with a drone.  Includes sopilka (Ukrainian)	Melody led homophony  Tempo steady c100bpm  Verse-chorus with some dance breaks	Aol1 – elements of traditional Ukrainian music, plus has taken on extra significance since war started  Aol3 – maybe – dance is an important element	Originally a song about motherhood, it has taken on deeper significance since the invasion. The band have been allowed out of Ukraine (as have some other artists) to represent the country when most men of fighting age are not able to leave.
